Office of Diversity and Inclusion Faculty Fellows Program

The Office of Diversity and Inclusion (ODI) Faculty Fellows work with staff from the ODI and across campus on special projects and initiatives related to creating a greater sense of belonging on campus. The Fellows work with senior administrators and shared governance representatives to obtain input on the project and develop a report for the President's Cabinet.

Activities: The current project is to develop a comprehensive diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI) strategic plan. To create the DEI strategic plan, Fellows will review the University's strategic plan and campus climate study, as well as seek input from students and employees from around campus. The plan should be developed by the conclusion of the spring semester, but the fellowship may be extended to work on implementation and other next steps. The Fellows Program requires a commitment of 5-10 hours per week.

Requirements: Faculty applicants must receive approval for the program from their department chair and school/college dean. A stipend will be granted to the selected Fellows and will be determined after consultation with the department and with consideration of the project's scope.
